Artstor is a non-profit online digital image library designed to serve the educational and scholarly communities with more than two million images on subjects in the arts, architecture, humanities, and social sciences. Artstor provides tools and software to search, present, and share digital images both online and offline.

Shared Shelf

Shared Shelf is a cloud-based media management tool that enables institutions to manage, store, use, and publish their institutional and faculty media collections privately, with the academic community, between institutions, or with the world.

Shared Shelf Commons

Shared Shelf Commons is a free, open-access library of images made available by institutions that subscribe to Shared Shelf, a cloud-based media management tool for cataloging and managing digital collections.
